1. Sketch the Layout in the Garden Bed squares.
2. Sketch the left, back, and right elevation views of the garden bed
3. Cut on the Dotted lines and fold on the Dashed lines to create a 3-D diorama
4. The grey boxes will get folded under, and they can be taped or stapled in place.
